Reviewer A:

I think this article is very good with new method that rarely used in Indonesian scholar, However I have some substantial comments to be considered before publication

- Please use a professional proof-reader before re-submitting their article.
- In the method, it is not clear what and which population are referred to and which villages or cities the samples taken from. As the authors mentioned the Slovin's formula to determine the sample size this population information is missing. The authors do not mention characteristics of the population in this section or in other parts in the result.
- Every mathematical equations requires numbering, so that it is easy for the readers and authors to name which equation the text refers to.
- The numbering of the figures is really confusing. There is a repeated Figure 1. Figure 1 mentions the word 'processed' after Source: BPS.... What does it mean? It is really confusing. I think the authors should remove the word 'Source' in the end of the Figure if it is sourced from primary data.
- The conclusion does not fully answer the research objective especially the third objective to calculate the economic value of the Lake. Also, there is poor discussion whether the value derived from this research can be validated using other research findings.

This paper presents an interesting contribution on the valuation of natural resources related to tourism. A couple areas that need to be improved:

- As you will see in the comments in the draft, the selection of method needs to be more clearly explained. You provide a nice background of the types of valuation but don't show how you select or apply your methodology. You also do a nice literature review but at times forget to tell us why you are highlighting a particular case. See comments in the draft on pages 4-5.
- The site location also seems to be selected at random. Please make a clearer explanation about the rationale for site selection.
- Selection of variables — independent / dependent and why variables were chosen is an important element of this research that is not explained.
- Section 3.2 is especially strange and is provided without any context. What does rice production have to do with environmental services or tourism of the lake and case study. It also includes language that is not contextualized or explained, which should have been described in the introduction.
