Reviewer comments:

Reviewer: The authors have made a great effort to identify the phytochemical profile of mangroves grown nearby the port where is frequently affected by adverse environmental impacts. The attained results are of interest for further discovering the potential bioactive compounds from this plant. However, the current form of paper has not been well documented and organized. The authors are requested to make critically revise and edit following the comments and suggestions (see details in pdf file):

- 1. Materials and Methods must be improved, some methods such as leaves sampling, environmental parameter sampling, hatching process, etc... should proved more information
- 2. Provide the method how to calculate IC50
- 3. Add one subsection as "Statistical analyses" or "Data analyses", how did the authors calculate the data as presented in Tables and Figs

- 4. Subsections 2.4 and 2.5 should be joined in one and the methods should be briefly narrated
- 5. Results part should be reworded and rearranged, consider moving the subsections 3.1 and 3.2 into the Materials and Methods part, then Table 3 should change as Fig is better
- 6. Discussion part must be improved. In my opinion, the chemical profile of mangroves with port activities identified in this study should be compared to other studies, for example, how about the chemical profile of mangroves grown in non-port activities, or nature or non-polluted areas.
- 7. English language including grammar errors, spelling, format must be rechecked and edits (see pdf file).
- 8. All cited references in the text must be listed in the references part and vice versa
- 9. All comments and suggestions in details were directly tracked in pdf file


