

The discussion is not well backed up by prior literature.

The objectives that must be attained have been discussed in this article. Nonetheless, the following should be noted:

1. Introduction

The authors only discuss the prevalence of smoking across Indonesia as a whole, not specifically in the study location. The Authoring team must additionally include an overview of the prevalence of smoking habit in the Java and Bali areas, taking into account aspects more than only the population and number of employees, in order to strengthen the argument for doing this case study in these two regions.

2. Material and Methods

The sampling technique used in this study should be described by the authors.

3. Discussion

Regarding the reasons why people continue to smoke at work, the authors performed an excellent job of comparing their findings with those of previous research. Nevertheless, the authors haven't gone into great depth in this draft on the reasons why some respondents still smoke at work in this research site.
