CONFERENCE TIMELINE

- 1. REGISTRATION, FULL PAPER SUBMISSION, AND REGISTRATION PAYMENT (BY 7 OCTOBER 2020)**
First, you need to create an EDAS account for yourself and for other authors if needed on https://bit.ly/sule_registration. In case you experience problems and cannot successfully set up the account, you can fill this form on http://bit.ly/sule_manual and we will do the rest of the account set up process. The full paper is submitted into EDAS system with the account you have created previously, or, as an alternative, you can also send the full paper to sule-ic@fkip.unsri.ac.id. The registration fee payment needs to be made no later than 7 October 2020 to secure your spot at the conference. The proof of payment is uploaded to https://bit.ly/sule_payment.
- 2. PAPER REVIEW AND LOA (BY 20 OCTOBER 2020)**
Your paper will be reviewed and will go through a similarity check. After the review process is completed, we will send you an email containing the review result form, similarity index form, Letter of Acceptance (LOA), and publication recommendation. If, later, you fail to find the email in your mail inbox, please check your email **spam** or contact the committee for more information.
- 3. PREPARATION, SUBMITTING PRESENTATION POWER POINT (BY 22 OCTOBER 2020)**
Before the conference day, you are required to send your presentation powerpoint to http://bit.ly/sule_ppt by Oct 22nd, 2020.
- 4. CONFERENCE DAY**

- 5. FINAL MANUSCRIPT (TWO WEEKS PERIOD POST CONFERENCE)**
