Garcia-Teodoro et al(Comp. Sec. 2009 -- cited >600 times!),

Lakhina et al (Comp. Comm. Rev, 2005 -- cited > 500 times!),

Sommer et al (Proc. IEEE Symp. Security & Privacy, 2010 - cited >400 times!) and many more.
