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Impact of Prostitution Localization (PMD) on the Education and Social of Youth Way Lunik, Bandar Lampung City

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Abstract

This study aims to determine the impact of the prostitution environment on the education and social environment of adolescents, education, social (moral and religious) and informal education related to the way parents educate local teenagers living in former localization area.. This study uses a qualitative approach with descriptive data analysis techniques. This research is located in the Teluk Tomini Views of Waylunik Village, Bandar Lampung City. The research subjects were 9 people and the data analysis technique used data collection procedures, data presentation, and drawing conclusions. The data validation technique uses time triangulation and subject triangulation. The results of this study indicate that the impact of the former Scenic Prostitution Localization on youth education is the lack of interest and desire for education because teenagers think education is not an important thing in their lives. The prostitution environment in which teenagers live has a bad influence. Although there are religious activities and parents provide religious education to teenagers, this still affects the personality, moral, social and behavioral development of adolescents. More attention is needed from parents and more encouragement for teenagers to have an interest and desire for education for teenagers who live in former scenic localizations.

I. Introduction

It has become commonplace. Prostitution is often manifested in a prostitution complex in Indonesia which is called lokalisasi. Localization as a place where a number of embroidery houses are concentrated (certain places inhabited by commercial sex workers to carry out prostitution) or shelters for prostitutes (WTS). The fact that prostitution is still the problem of prostitution which was once considered a taboo by the Indonesian people is currently growing and is increasingly causing various unrest in the community, the impacts that will later be caused by an environment like this if allowed to continue side by side with people's lives can disturb comfort, security and public order. Not to mention the other negative impacts that will arise from this prostitution environment will later have a bad influence on the personality and social life of the teenagers who grow and develop in the localization environment of the daily lives of teenagers in prostitution. In addition to fears of a moral decline due to the bad environment in which teenagers live, it is also vulnerable to social deviations or deviant behavior carried out by teenagers because they are affected by the bad environment of prostitution. deviant behavior or juvenile delinquency who live in the vicinity of prostitution such as consuming liquor, smoking, fighting and making out in public places and there are even some teenagers who choose not to continue their education because they have been affected by the adverse effects of the prostitution environment in their place of residence.

In addition, the negative impact arising from the existence of localization, for example, occurs in teenagers who live around the location, ordinary teenagers follow the habits of PSK (commercial sex workers) starting from how to dress, socialize, and also easily issue dirty words. in daily life. In addition, those who live near the localization area are also vulnerable to the notion that they are not comfortable because they live near the environment localization so that the assumption of outsiders assumes that those who live in the area are the same as the residents. The condition of the social environment of the community around the localization has always been a concern of the general public. Negative views are always given to the community around the localization. The vulnerability of children and adolescents in the localization environment from associations that can damage them. Children in the lokalisasi should get more attention because without realizing it, lokalisasi provides a bad influence and example for them. Starting from the practice of prostitution, gambling to drugs, it is feared that it can affect teenagers around the lokalisasi. (According to Elund, Lena & Evelyn Korn, 2002) In the Journal of A Theory of prostitution Vol.110, No.1 The University of Chicago. Prostitution and prostitution have a very bad impact on teenagers, including the following: Generating and spreading venereal and skin diseases such as:

Syphilis and Gonorrhea (gonorrhea) Demoralizes or gives a demoralizing effect to the environment, especially young adolescents during puberty and adolescence. Correlated with crime and addiction to narcotic substances (marijuana, morphine, heroin, etc.). This destroys moral, ethical, legal, and religious joints so that it can cause impotence, anorgasm, nymphomania, atyriasis, premature and premature ejaculation.

II. Review of Literature

Prostitution Localization

According to (Kondar Sagar: 2015) Prostitution itself comes from the Latin prostitute which means allowing oneself to commit adultery, commit prostitution, fornication and fornication. (Yayan: 2015) Prostitution or what is known as prostitution itself is a form of social disease in an old society (Kartono, 2019:177). Prostitution is a social disease that must be stopped from spreading without neglecting efforts.

Prostitution is a very complex problem because it involves various aspects of people's lives, both from social, gender, legal, health, economic, moral and ethical aspects, religion, education, psychology, and politics.

G Sihombing said that "Prostitution means that sexual behavior with multiple partners can be carried out by both men and women". The practice of prostitution or prostitution grows and develops in Indonesia. In fact, there is no area in Indonesia that does not recognize the practice of prostitution or prostitution (Zulfiqar, et al, 2014:1199).

III. Research Method

This research uses descriptive qualitative method. The data used are primary data and secondary primary data obtained from research subjects using the interview method where this research will be carried out at the localization location of the Waylunik village, Bandar Lampung city which is a place for prostitution localization which is close to the surrounding community. The focus of the research is the youth localization environment and the surrounding community in the localization with the research subject.

- (1) The background factors causing the emergence of the localization environment and its influence on the social morals of adolescents living in the localization environment
- (2) The impact of prostitution localization on adolescent education, social morals and adolescent attitudes
- (3) The way parents provide education to adolescents living in ex prostitution localization.

The data collection techniques carried out in this study used observation and interview techniques while the research subjects were as follows:

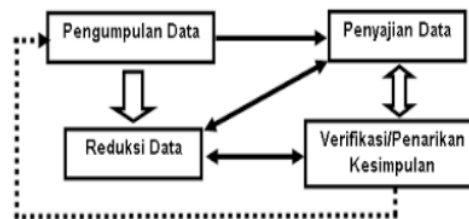

IV. Results and Discussion

The Impact of Prostitution Localization on the Education and Socialization of Youth in the Way Lunik sub-district, Bandar Lampung city

Adolescence is the most critical period, a period where there is a passionate desire to break away from dependence on parents and try to achieve independence so that later it can be accepted and recognized as adults. day to night, namely gathering activities with peers. These activities usually include gathering, chatting, playing online games such as mobile legends, PUBG, etc., also playing Playstation is a routine for teenage boys in the ex-localization area, while for young girls usually just eating snacks and buying food and drinks or chatting at local-owned stalls. but not infrequently also joined with teenage boys. Some of the teenagers there have received formal education, but they only make it a routine, not a formality that is quite important for teenagers. Harmony in the form of relationships and

communication of children in the family is also a determinant of how children will behave in their social environment. Based on the results of observations and interviews of researchers with several teenagers who live in ex-localization that communication and relationships with other family members are going well. The relationship and communication between adolescents and parents looks good as well as expressed by the parents about the relationship and communication with their children.

The family is an informal educational path for educational children that is obtained by someone from everyday experiences both consciously and unconsciously. The family is also known as a unit or institution that can meet individual needs. Especially the need for development of personality, morals, behavior and the human race. Through good treatment and care by parents, children can fulfill their physical (biological) and socio-psychological needs.

Broadly speaking, there are two factors that influence personality development, namely heredity factors (genetics) and environmental factors (environment). The environment has an important role for adolescent personality development. Based on observations and interviews, prostitution certainly has a bad influence on the personality of teenagers, with examples of many violating norms such as prostitution, gambling, drinking alcoholic beverages openly, both women and men. The bad environment of the ex-localization is recognized as having a bad impact.

Education is important for a nation because education will certainly print quality human resources and educators are also a process of printing the nation's next generation. Teenagers are the next generation of the nation in their hands. Human Resources (HR) is the most important component in a company or organization to run the business it does. Organization must have a goal to be achieved by the organizational members (Niati et al., 2021). Development is a change towards improvement. Changes towards improvement require the mobilization of all human resources and reason to realize what is aspired (Shah et al, 2020). The development of human resources is a process of changing the human resources who belong to an organization, from one situation to another, which is better to prepare a future responsibility in achieving organizational goals (Werdhiastutie et al, 2020).

Later the fate of the Indonesian nation will be determined. The National Law number 3 of 2003 concerning the education system states that the education pathway consists of formal, informal and non-formal education. Formal education is education that is held in schools. In general, this educational path has a clear level of education, ranging from basic education to higher education. Non-formal education is an educational pathway outside of formal education which is carried out in a structured and tiered manner. Meanwhile, informal education is a path of family and environmental education in the form of independent learning activities that are carried out consciously.

Adolescence is a period where it is considered a period of storm and stress because they already have the free will to determine their own destiny, if they are well directed, teenagers will become individuals who have a sense of responsibility, but if they are not guided properly these teenagers will be someone who has a bad future. Moreover, in terms of the association of teenagers, they still need supervision, guidance and direction because in their daily life, teenagers cannot be separated from association with peers and the environment in which they live. Based on the findings in the field, the association of teenagers living in the ex-localization of Scenery is colored by various kinds of behavior, both normal and deviant behavior for teenagers of their age. Deviant behavior is behavior that is not appropriate, cannot be accepted by the general public and is not in accordance with existing norms. Examples of deviant behavior carried out by teenagers in ex-prostitution premises such as: women smoking, drinking liquor, dating and making out in public places.

According to Mark S Gaylord and John F Balliber and Edwin Sutherland in Kartini Kartini: 2013, people who have deviant behavior tend to have social ties with other people who have deviant behavior where the person reinforces deviant norms and values. In principle, every social group will indirectly pass on values and norms to new members. If it is related to events in the field, the deviant influence carried out by teenagers cannot be separated from the influence of the prostitution environment and local residents who prioritize free and deviant lifestyles such as drinking liquor, smoking, making trouble, making out in public and committing adultery freely such as prostitution activities. The daily activities of teenagers which are generally filled with gathering and staying up late and the lack of activities that lead to positive things are added to the pandemic period which causes more and more time to be used unproductively.

Adolescents and adults living in ex-localizations are mixed and integrated in good social relations. While for parents in the family it is seen as the main determinant in the formation of a child's personality on the grounds that the family is the first social group that becomes the center of identification of children, many children spending time in the family environment and family members are "significant people" for the formation of the child's personality. The family is also a unit or institution for children in personality development through parental care and treatment through good treatment and care, the child will later grow into a good person, therefore the role of parents is important in nurturing, supervising, educating and controlling activities of children, especially children who are in their teens. If it is related to the findings in the field, parents have given treatment and paid attention to their children well, although there are some who do not get the same treatment from their parents. However, these parents tend to obey the wishes of their children without good direction with a low parental educational background, making parents only provide basic educational knowledge in addition to environmental factors and economic factors which are relatively low, as evidenced by Mr. and Jh who could not continue his education and chose to work. Whereas through education about inculcating positive values of life, both religious and socio-cultural, it is a conducive factor to prepare children to become healthy and productive individuals and citizens of society. A bad environment such as the prostitution environment where teenagers live is certainly very influential on the personality development of teenagers, the roles and responsibilities of parents are very important so that teenagers grow up to be good individuals and away from the bad influence of the prostitution environment. As explained by Ariyono Suryono in Suseno : 2008 that the environment is a situation, condition and the surrounding area with all the forces of organisms that influence all the development of their behavior. If it is associated with the findings in the field in terms of controlling and supervising the association of teenagers with bad environments such as prostitution, parents have different ways. his son. Meanwhile, parents give directions to their children not to play outside too often. In providing education, parents have a form, type, method given to children by parents in educating, guiding and disciplining and protecting children to reach maturity according to the norms expected by society in general, how to educate parents will certainly have different consequences for the development of children's behavior.

Based on the findings in the field, most parents use a method of educating children that is not too harsh but is still given supervision but tends to free up what the child wants to do, there is no punishment that is too harsh if the child makes a mistake, just giving advice and warning usually causes the child often underestimate and do not listen to what parents have to say . It should be in an environment like this that parents would be better off educating their children by being in two-way communication with children, providing signs in getting along, being firm in educating and directing children to positive activities but still

providing opportunities for children to make choices so that children who stepped on as a teenager grew up to be a good person even though he lived in the ex-Sights Localization environment.

The environment certainly plays a very important role, especially the prostitution environment, as stated by Bonger in Kartono (2013), prostitution or prostitution is a social phenomenon where women sell themselves to do sexual acts as a livelihood. From this explanation, in the ex-localization of scenery, many women sell themselves as a livelihood, the commercial sex workers (PSK) who work in the ex-localization of scenery are driven by family economic factors and low education.

In addition to prostitution activities, it also sells various liquors, provides music cafes and gambling activities. Broadly speaking, there are two main factors that influence personality development, namely heredity (genetics) and environmental factors (environment). Ex-Localization Scenery is a social environment that will adversely affect the development of individual personalities, especially children and adolescents. For example, the poor quality of youth in the ex-localization environment is choosing not to continue their education, becoming unemployed and still doing negative activities. The prostitution environment that does not attach importance to the prevailing norms makes teenagers become influenced and eventually imitates activities that are not properly carried out during adolescence even though during adolescence it should be filled with useful things such as studying and joining various organizations. Lack of enthusiasm to reach a good future due to lack motivation in such an environment In the 2003 national education system that the educational environment is informal, formal and non-formal education. From this statement, it is intended that informal education is education that is obtained by a person through everyday experiences, consciously or unconsciously, such as in a family or community environment. Formal education is obtained by someone regularly, systematically, graded and by following clear and strict conditions such as school. Non-formal education or what is often referred to as education outside of school is education that is obtained by a person in a regular, deliberate manner but does not follow strict regulations but still follows government requirements or conditions made by the government in accordance with national education. Non-formal education is functional and practical with the aim of increasing work skills and abilities, such as special sewing institutes and package schools to continue education. Teenagers in the former location are still studying and stop at the junior high school level or at most feel that they have just finished high school. Thus, education among the youth of Kampung Sawahscene is not too important even though education has an important function for people's lives. as stated. All of these functions are indeed a very important process so that community life continues to survive and develop for the better.

V. Conclusion

Based on the results of the study, it was concluded that many teenagers who lived in the ex-localization of Landscape did not continue their formal education. This was due to the lack of support from family, economy and environment who did not attend non-formal education at all. Only the informal education path is the access to education that can be independently obtained by teenagers through their families and living environment and the existence of prostitution environments such as ex-localization of scenery has a negative impact on adolescent relationships. Adolescent morals and the behavior of teenagers who live in prostitution environments tend to fill their activities with deviant activities so that parents are obliged to prevent juvenile delinquency there.

The education applied by parents to adolescents in the ex-localization scene, parents tend to give freedom to children in determining their life choices. Parents tend to pay less attention to the association of teenagers who live in ex-localization but parents continue to carry out religious activities at home and abroad. the mosque where they live. It is recommended that parents pay more attention to and direct the education and association of teenagers who live side by side with the environment, such as to more positive activities so that in the future the teenagers will grow up to be good individuals even though they live in a prostitution environment that is ex-scene localization.

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
